Dreams

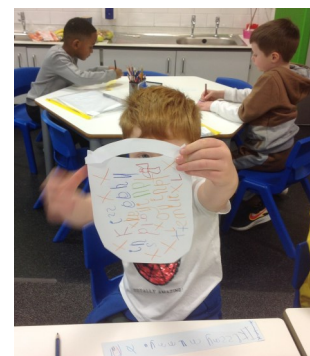
But if I can do some good in this world,

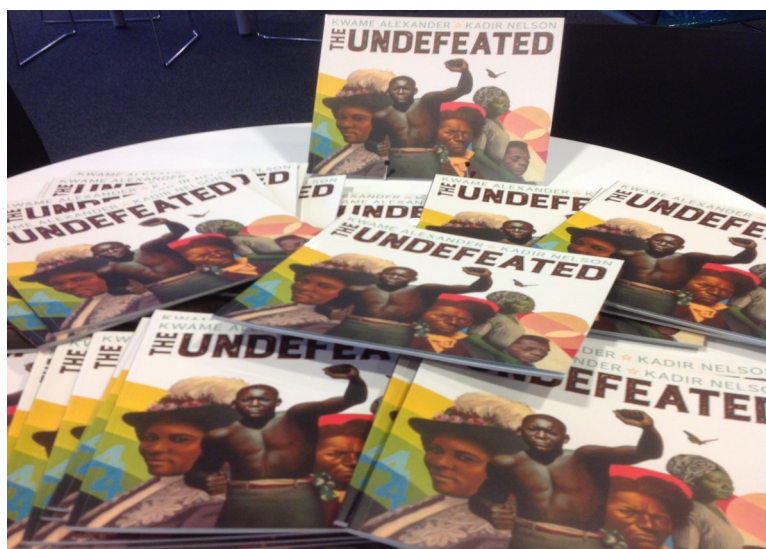
