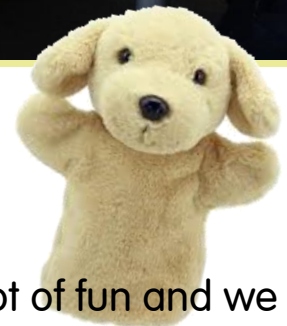
READING CLUB

Years 1 - 7 students spend a day with the brilliant Donavan Christopher AKA PAPPAMAN for National Poetry Day.



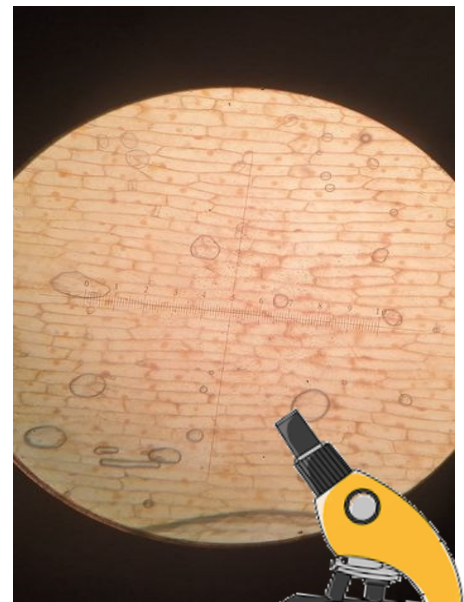
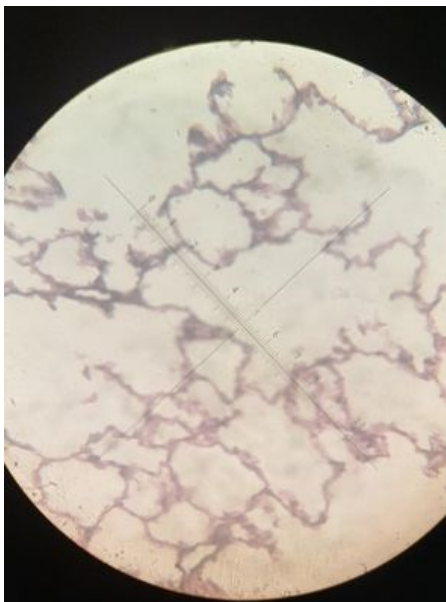

Year 5 have been working with the OAA team every Friday. They've been on the climbing wall.

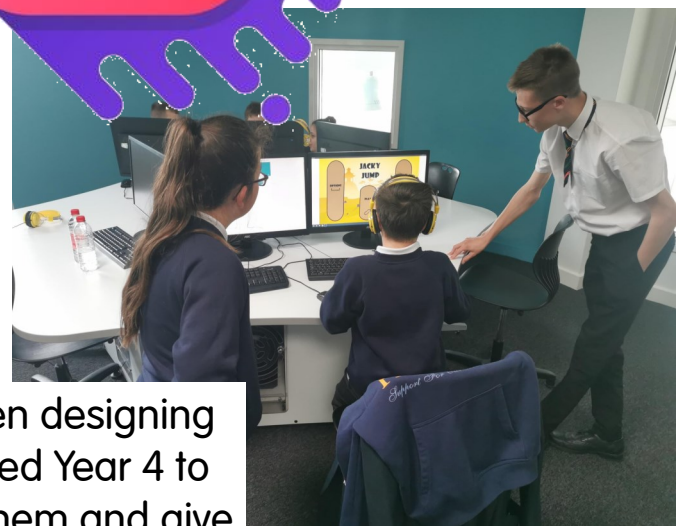
Climbing Club



Year 5 and Year 6 are enjoying lego club on a Monday lunchtime. They are being very creative and using social skills to discuss their creations.

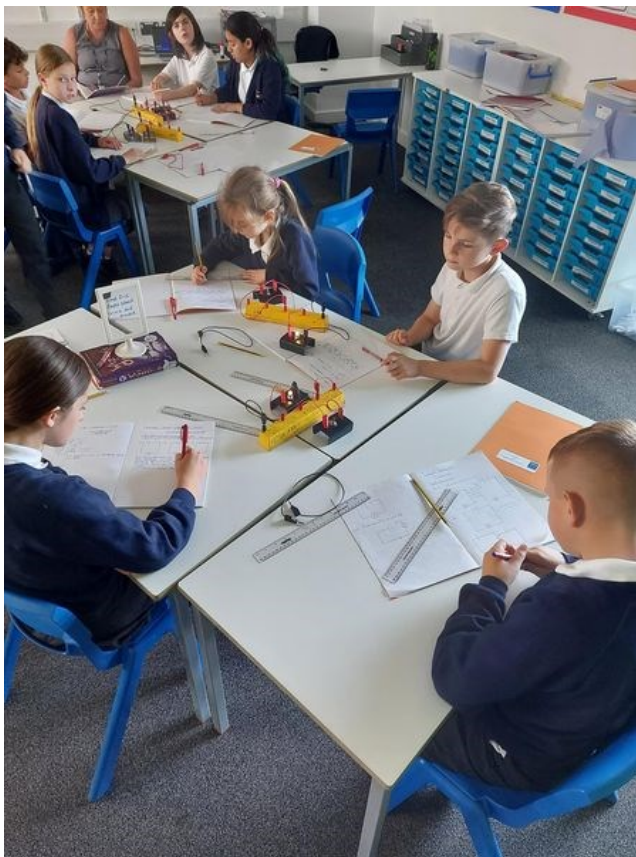


Mrs Jeffrey's Y9 science class were viewing cells through microscopes and have some great photos taken by L. Lawton Y9

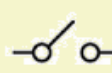

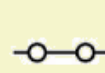

Year 6 have been reading 'The Fib' and have had a zoom call with George Layton the author of the book.



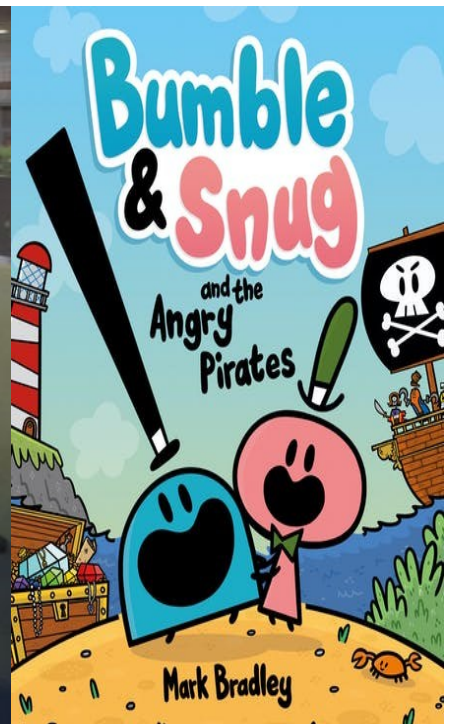
Year 6 Bookworms

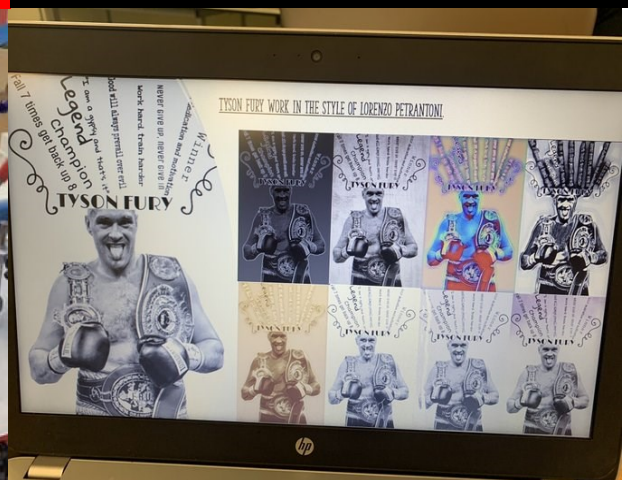
