## First or second dose – COVID-19 vaccine for children aged 12 to 15

Dear Parent/Carer

As you may be aware from January in line with the government guidance and following advice from the UK's chief medical officers all 12–15-year-old children are now offered the second dose of Pfizer-BioNtech COVID-19 vaccination.

**I am pleased to let you know that there is an additional opportunity for your child to receive the first dose or second dose of COVID-19 vaccine through:**

Jacobs Well Vaccination site – Available every day from 4<sup>th</sup> January (4pm – 7pm) appointments can be booked via the National Booking system, or you could walk in.

We will also be at your child's school on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> of March at 9:00am offering 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> doses to those whose parents have given consent but could not be vaccinated when we last visited, for instance due to illness.

- If you wish your child to have the vaccine in school, please contact the team on 01274 221269 so we can take verbal consent over the telephone (consent will only be taken from a parent or legal guardian). This applies for the first or second dose of vaccine.
- If a school session has already taken place at your child's school, we will sign post you to a vaccination centre for the vaccine.

The consenting process at the vaccination hub at Jacobs Well will be carried out at the same time the vaccine is administered so it is important that you attend with your child. If you wish to give consent for your child to be vaccinated at school, please contact the school and ask for a consent form.

Please do not contact your GP about this as they will be unable to offer an alternative.
