As you will be aware, Her Majesty the Queen becomes the first British monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee this year, as she marks 70 years of service to the people of the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth.

To recognise this, we are having a jubilee celebration week in school beginning on Monday 23 May 2022. During the week, the children will be taking part in a range of activities, including learning about the monarchy, the changes that have occurred in the different decades, as well as participating in arts and crafts projects.

On Friday 27 May 2022, we will be having a red, white and blue themed non-uniform day, allowing children to come to school wearing clothes in the colours of the Union Jack. Our kitchen staff are joining in the celebrations too, and have created a jubilee themed lunch, and class parties will also take place.

The children will also be receiving a commemorative book which has been gifted by the government – Queen Elizabeth: A Platinum Jubilee Celebration – which takes children on a journey through Her Majesty the Queen's life.
