Getting started

What your child will need to use CENTURY:

- An internet enabled device using an up-to-date version of Chrome or Safari
- A desk or table and somewhere comfortable to sit
- Pen and paper for notes and workings out
- Headphones



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Supporting your learner at home



Reduce Distractions

Ensure the room they are in is free of distractions, e.g. television off.



Take Breaks

Allow your child short breaks whilst they are working.

School Advice

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Keep in touch with school and follow any advice they set out with regard to teaching and learning.

Encouraging your child

- Take an interest. Ask them about what they are learning.
- Use the learning materials at the start of each nugget If you are unfamiliar with the topic yourself; there is always a choice of video or learning cards which explain the topic at the start of each nugget.
- Use the parent portal to look at their progress. You can take a look their their strengths and weaknesses and encourage them to be reflective learners.
- Say well done/ praise Take a look at your child's achievements and reward them.



How to Log in

Scroll though 'My tracker' to see your child's nugget scores. The headers can be toggled in ascending and descending order.

Click the nugget name to see your child's nugget attempt data.

In this new window, you can click the (+) button to view their scores, how long they spent completing the nugget and drill down to see your child's answers to identify any misconceptions.

Top Tip!

If your child has achieved a low score, check to see they have spent enough time looking at the learning material. If they have looked at the slideshow, try viewing the video and trying again.





How can my child be a more independent learner?



'My Strengths' lists the 5 highest scoring nuggets for your child in the course.

'My Areas for Improvement' lists the lowest scoring nuggets for your child in the course.

The 'Stretch Myself' and 'Focus for Improvement' nugget lists are the next steps CENTURY has identified for your child and will be likely to appear in the Recommended Path for your child.

Top Tip!

What if my child or I forgets our login details?

You can click on the 'Forgot your password?' link and enter your details for an email to be sent to your account to reset your password. Your child's teacher can also reset their password.

What is a nugget?

There are two types of nugget:

1) A diagnostic contains no learning material and is a mini-quiz. The data from these diagnostics are used to kick start your child's personalised recommendations on CENTURY.

2) A normal nugget is a mini-lesson on a topic within a subject. This contains learning materials in the form of a slideshow or a video.

What are the keys?

The keys are called 'Reveals'. They give you the opportunity to reveal the correct answer for questions you have answered incorrectly. Students are given three keys which refresh every hour.

Does every child have their own personalised pathway?

Yes, CENTURY's pathway is different for every student, based on how they answer questions in diagnostics and nuggets. The pathway will adjust based on the student's strengths and weaknesses.
