

Nursery Snow Day Plan! (10/03/2023)

- Get outside and build a snowman (or whatever else you would like to build!) what features does your snowman need to make his face? What can you use to create those features?
- Cosy up with your favourite story, who are the characters? Where is the story set? Why is this your favourite story? Can you draw a picture of the characters from your story?
- Explore the weather outside, how does the snow feel to touch? Does it have a smell? Why has it snowed? Where has the snow come from? Has the snow changed the way other things feel- could leaves be frozen, does that change the way they feel?
- Have a group of items in a pile – can you help to count them? What is the best way to do it? – emphasise placing them in a line and counting them with our pointy finger, slowly and starting from the beginning of the line.
- Have a box and place 5 musical objects or everyday objects in the box ready to use. You sing to the tune of ‘Old Macdonald’ ‘Mrs Brown has a box e i e i o and if that box she has a.....’ you then get one of the instruments/objects to make a sound and children guess the object (Phonic)
