# National Changes

In recent years, the Government has made significant changes to qualifications that students can take in key stage 4 including;

• Ending resits

Part of the

- An expectation that students will leave school with more qualifications than previously – 8 not 5
- GCSEs and BTECs becoming more rigorous and ALL with examined content at the end of the course
- Changes to the grading of GCSEs from letters to numbers





Students achieving "good" grades in English, maths, science, a humanities subject and a language will be classed as having achieved the EBACC.

Students do NOT receive an extra certificate for this. It is simply a suite of qualifications that make up the EBACC.

Some universities want students to have the EBacc suite of qualifications as part of their entry criteria. These are usually "Russell group" universities.





# Changes at Appleton



## Appleton will NOT be offering triple science. Combined Science

- All colleges will accept combined science to access A level courses.
- This won't affect students' opportunities for science-based careers.
- Students will receive two GCSEs for science.

### **Triple Science**

If you child wants to study triple science, they will be able to opt in to after school sessions where the extra content will be covered.

## Additional opportunities alongside GCSE's



#### The Scholars Programme

- Aimed at a cohort of students selected by staff who have the potential to go on to achieve a university degree or higher level apprenticeship (expected to achieve at least grade 4/5 at GCSE in most subjects)
- Would benefit from curriculum enhancements to provide access to "secret knowledge" that is so often engrained into students who are from grammar schools
- The programme will build on the knowledge, attitudes, skills and habits needed to ensure that students can compete on an equal playing field and not feel like a "fish out of water" when exposed to new situations
- Will be launched with selected students and their parents on Wednesday 20th March in the
