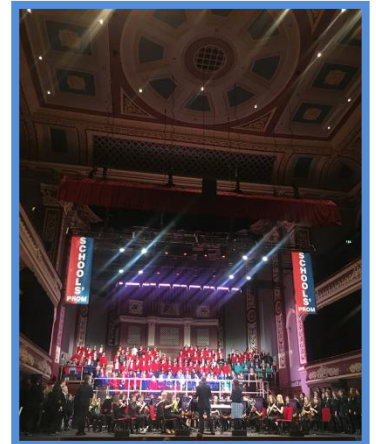




# Performing Arts

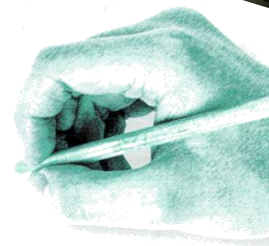
# Library

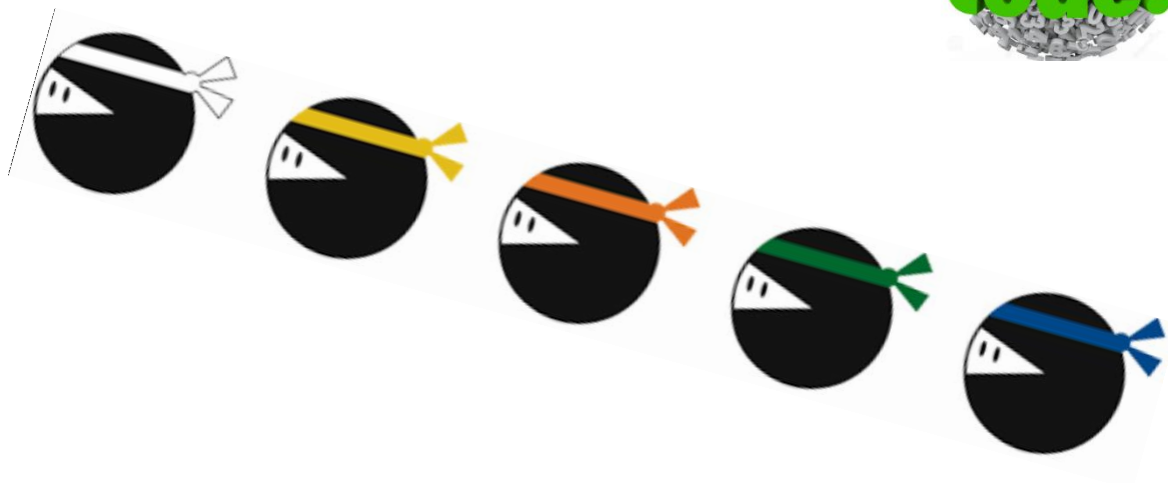
# Maths

Students will also be given the opportunity to participate in colouring in their own mandalas. [OBJ]

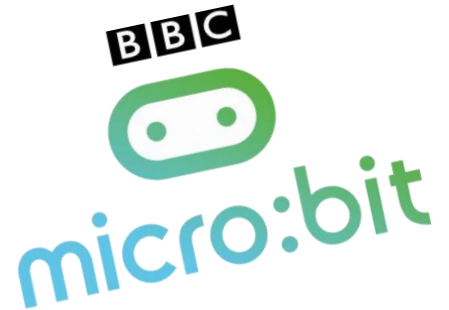




# Digital Literacy
