Dear Parent/Carer

We are excited to inform you about the upcoming Red Nose Day events at our school, which will take place this Friday 21 March 2025. This is a day dedicated to raising funds for charity while engaging our students in fun and meaningful activities. Below are the details of our planned events:

- Who's the Funniest: Throughout the week, staff members have been submitting their funniest jokes. On Friday, students will vote on these jokes during form time to decide whose is the funniest. Students can also submit their own jokes, with the best one winning a prize. Jokes must be appropriate and students should include their name with any submission, which they can make via their form tutor.
- **Own Clothes Day**: Students can wear their own clothes for the day by donating £1.00. Clothing should be appropriate for a school environment and not carry inappropriate slogans or images or be revealing.
- **Table Tennis**: Students can book a 10-minute slot for £1.00 to play table tennis with a partner.
- Guess How Many Sweets in the Jar: For 20p a turn, students can guess the number of sweets in a jar. The correct guess wins the sweets.
- **Guess the Name of the Cuddly Toy**: For 20p a turn, students can guess the name of our Red Nose Day cuddly toy. The correct guess wins the cuddly toy.
- **Students' vs Staff Dodgeball Game**: A dodgeball game between students and staff will be held in the MUGA. Entry is 50p and participants will be selected by a draw if we have a large number of interested student participants.
- **Bingo**: A bingo game will be held in the auditorium with 30 spaces available. Entry is £1.00 per strip with prizes to be won.
- **Sports Hall and Dance Studio Games**: Various games and activities will be available for 50p admission in our sports hall and dance studio.
- Karaoke: Karaoke sessions will be held in the drama studio for 50p.
- Games Room: The games room will feature air hockey, and a FIFA tournament.
- Who's Being Sponged: Students will have the chance to sponge selected staff members at a cost of £1.00 per person for three sponges.
