Please find below the timetable for your child to complete during the school closure. The children can work through the lessons set each day which have a mixture of online learning and fun activities to do at home.

Day 1 Wednesday	Subject	Activity
	Literacy	Transitions- (Will be discussed with the children on Live Lesson via Teams 9-9:30/ 10:30-11) Watch the episode Topsy and Tim's First Day at school. https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b04kklnt/topsy-and-tim-series-2-29-first-day How do you think Topsy and Tim are feeling? How are you feeling about going into a new class? What would you like to do in your new class? What do you think you will learn in your new class
	Phonics	Talk about the different instruments your child knows and how they make different sounds – explain we will make our own With your child get them to make their own shakers. Use plastic cups and rice/beans/oats, tin foil and elastic bands. Allow chn to choose how much they would like to put in but remind them that too much might break the foil Give your child opportunity to experiment with their shaker.
	Maths	Collect some of your child's favourite toys (no more than 5) and arrange them on the floor/ on a tray, can your child tell you how many there are? Get your child to turn around/ shut their eyes or just cover the toys and take one away. Which one is missing? If there were _____ there before, how many are there now? Repeat with different amounts of toys.
	Theme	Transitions- What do you want your teacher to know about you? Can you draw a picture of your favourite food, favourite toy, favourite story character and anything else you would like them to know, maybe something you really don't like!

Day 2 Thursday	Subject	Activity
	Literacy	Transitions- Who lives in your house? Can you draw a picture of the people who you live with to show your teacher so that they can learn all about you, don't forget to include any pets who live in your house too!
	Phonics	Use the shaker your child made yesterday to create music. Ask the children to shake to 10 and back. With your child sing familiar nursery rhymes and shake to the beat
	Maths	Have a group of household items in a pile – can the children help to count them? What is the best way to do it? – emphasise placing them in a line and counting them with our pointy finger, slowly and starting from the beginning of the line.
	Theme	Transitions- - (Will be discussed with the children on Live Lesson via Teams 9-9:30/ 10:30-11) What would you like to know about your teacher? Think of some questions to ask them about themselves, maybe get an adult to write them down for you ready for September. It could be about them, or about their classroom or about being in their class! It is up to you!
