Potential options available to you after Year 11

COLLEGE

College is somewhere you can go after Year 11 instead of sixth form.
Offers courses like A-Levels, BTECs, T Levels and practical trades.
Gives you skills for work or university.
More independent – no uniform, flexible timetable.
A fresh start with new people.

It's a great option if you want more choice, independence and career-focused learning.

6TH FORM

Sixth form is staying on at school after Year 11 to study for two more years (Year 12 & 13).
You usually study A-Levels or BTECs.
It feels like school – same building and teachers.
There may be a dress code, rules and a structured timetable.

It's a good choice if you want to stay in a school environment and focus on academic subjects.

APPRENTICESHIP

An apprenticeship lets you work and study at the same time after Year 11.
You get a real job, earn a wage, and work with experienced staff.
You also spend time at college or with a training provider to gain a qualification.
Available in lots of areas like construction, childcare, business, hair & beauty, engineering and more.

You learn on the job, get paid, and build skills for your future career.

SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP

A supported internship is a work-based study programme for young people aged 16–24 who have an EHCP (Education, Health and Care Plan).

You spend most of your time in a real workplace, learning skills for employment.
You are supported by a job coach to help you learn tasks and become more independent.
You also work towards qualifications like English, maths and employability skills.

It's designed to help young people with additional needs move into paid work.

STUDY PROGRAMMES

Study study programme is a full-time course at a training provider (or some colleges) for 16–19 year olds.

It usually includes:

- Your main course (e.g. BTEC, vocational or skills-based)
- English and maths (if you didn't get grade 4)
- Work experience or work-related learning

It helps you build qualifications, skills and experience to move on to a job, apprenticeship or higher course.


